KinderZone Program

*KinderZone operates from AM Kindergarten dismissal until regular school dismissal,
Monday through Friday, on all school days.*

Kids' Zone Program Information:

- Manteca Parks & Recreation offers Before-School, After-School and KinderZone Programs (collectively called "Kids' Zone") at selected Manteca Unified School District elementary schools, based on demand. Contact our office, check our website, or look in the current Activity Guide for a list of school sites offering each program.
- The Kids' Zone Program is designed for children in Kindergarten through 7th grade. The program promotes the social, physical, and intellectual development of children.
- The After-School Program operates from regular school dismissal time until 6:00 PM.
- The Before-School Program operates from 6:30 AM until the start of the regular school day. Children may participate in the school breakfast program at a cost of 75 cents a day (25 cents reduced cost if qualified).

KinderZone Information:

- A snack is provided daily; however, Kindergarteners are required to have eaten lunch prior to attending the KinderZone program (parents, either send your child with a sack lunch or arrange for him/her to buy lunch in the school cafeteria).
- A quiet time for reading or homework is provided daily.
- Arts and crafts and cooperative games are offered daily.
- Educational games and indoor/outdoor activities will be available.

Staff Requirements (Benefits to You):

- Kids' Zone employees have E.C.E. units and/or experience working with school-age children
- Staff are CPR/First Aid and Epi-Pen certified
- Staff must pass Department of Justice fingerprint clearance and TB skin test
- Employees complete two hours of professional growth training each month
- Kids' Zone employees truly enjoy working with school-age children!

Registration and Program Fees:

Registration is accepted at the Manteca Parks and Recreation office only; **not** at MUSD school sites. Parents will need to complete an annual (each school year) registration packet and pay the annual membership fee of \$15.00 per child prior to children attending the program. You will be given a parent handbook at the time of registration. This handbook offers more detailed information about the Kids' Zone programs, policies, and requirements.

Program Fees (per child):

- Monthly: \$115.00
- Weekly: \$50.00
- Daily (drop-in): \$20.00
