



## Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Summary of Cases San Joaquin County

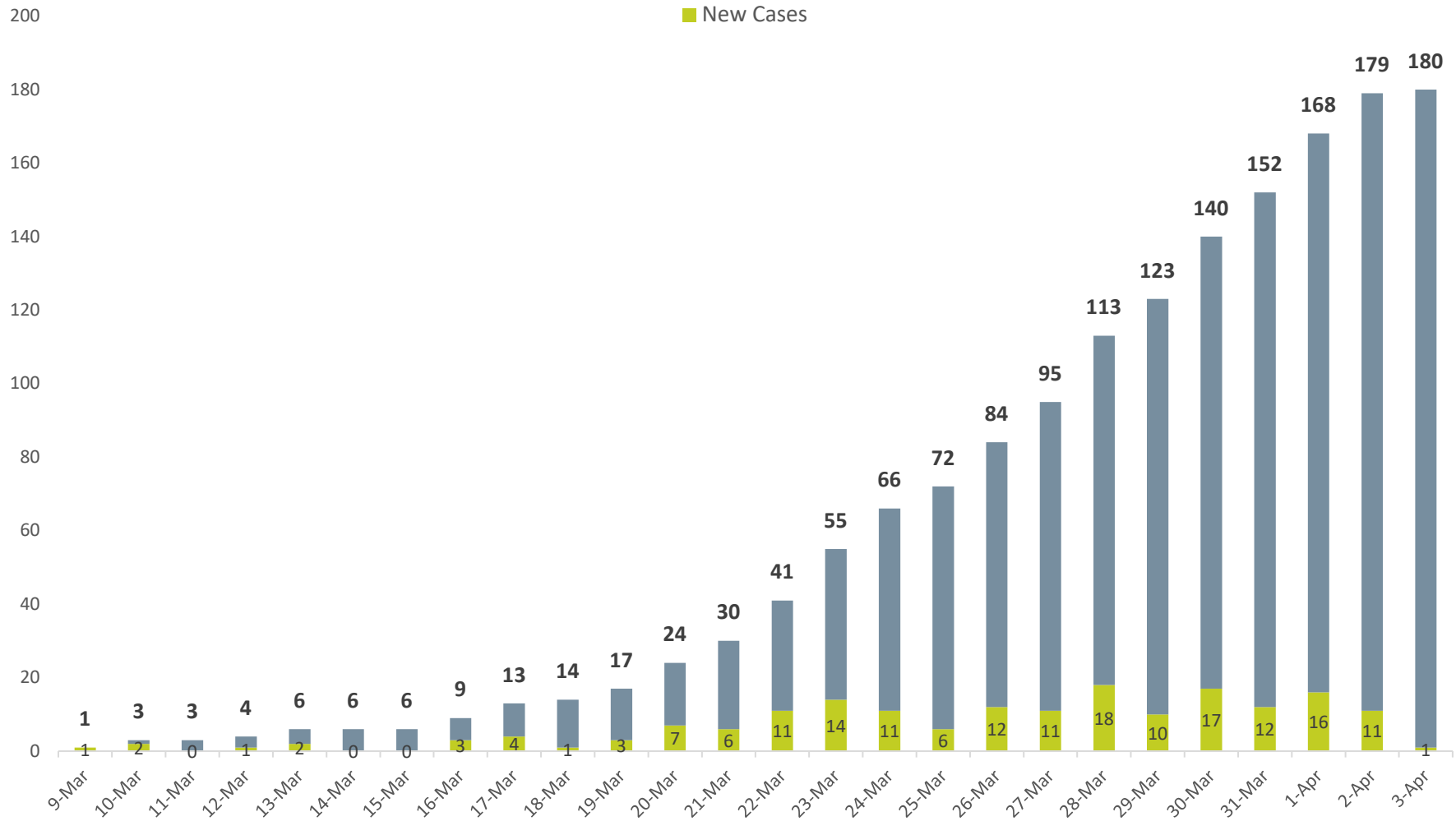
**Status as of April 3, 2020 (@09:00) (Data is preliminary and subject to change)**

COVID-19 Cases among San Joaquin County Residents - New Cases and Total Cases by Date Reported, Total Cases (N=180)

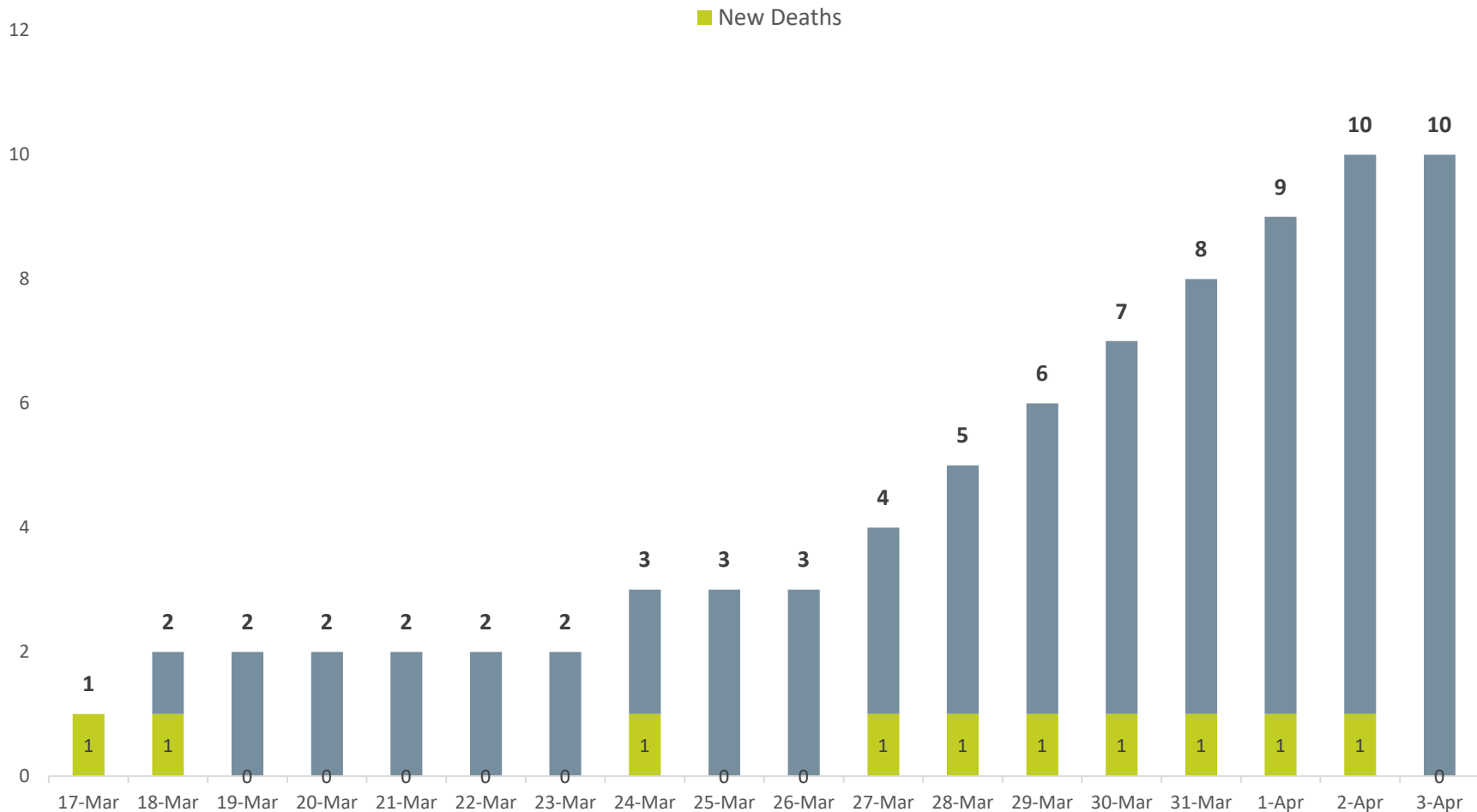
