

NOTICE OF ELECTION AND NOTICE OF DATE FIXED FOR SUBMITTING ARGUMENTS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the following measure is to be voted on at the General Municipal Election, to be held within the City of Manteca, County of San Joaquin, on Tuesday, November 3, 2020. Polling places will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.

Shall the measure adopting an ordinance to maintain City of Manteca services, such as fire protection; emergency response times/disaster preparedness; keeping public spaces safe/clean; pothole/street repairs; crime prevention; local business/jobs support; youth/teen recreation and after-school programs; and other general services, by establishing a 1¢ per dollar (1.0%) sales tax until ended by voters, generating approximately \$12,000,000 annually, with independent citizen oversight, and all funds used locally, be adopted? NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that not later than 5:00 p.m. on **August 14, 2020**, is hereby fixed as the final date and time for the filing of arguments, not to exceed three hundred (300) words in length, in favor or against the measure. To be eligible for printing and distribution as provided by law, any such arguments must be received and filed with the **Manteca City Clerk's Office, 1001 W. Center Street, Manteca CA 95337** no later than said date and time and must be accompanied by a Statement of Accuracy, pursuant to California Elections Code section 9600, and be signed and dated by the proponent(s) and author(s), if different.

NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that if an argument in favor of and an argument against the measure are submitted, copies will be provided to the respective authors in order that they may submit a rebuttal argument not to exceed two hundred fifty (250) words. Rebuttal arguments must be filed not later than 5:00 p.m. on **August 24, 2020**, and must also be accompanied by a Statement of Accuracy, signed and dated by the author(s).
