Section 3.1 General Requirements: The system proposed is Microsoft Windows™ based

The City has requested the proposed system to be Windows-based and for the system to run on Windows Server 2019 and Windows 10. Is it the desire of the City to have an onsite installation and hosting of the proposed solution by the City or are Web-Based and/or Cloud-based solutions acceptable if built on Microsoft technologies and use a Windows-based browser to the system?

Onsite installation and hosting.

Section 3.1, General Requirements: CAD and Records Management are one integrated system, not two systems interfaced to each other.

The City has requested an integrated system, not a system that interfaces to each other. Would it be acceptable if the proposed solution acted as a single fully integrated system though behind the scenes it may be two products from the same vendor? (i.e. from the user's point of view, they are using one single system without the need to log in or go from one system to another and there is no indication that it isn't a single system.)
