

## QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS NO. 2

To aid in the preparation of the response to the Request for Proposals (RFP), please find the following Questions and Answers that comprise Q & A No. 2:

### Question 1

Will the City be extending the LWA contract for the duration of this project?

### Answer 1

The Time of Performance (Term) for the Professional Services Agreement (PSA) with Larry Walker Associates is through December 31, 2019. The City of Manteca does not anticipate extending the PSA.

### Question 2

If the City is extending the contract, will the services by LWA be comparable to their current scope of services?

### Answer 2

The City does not anticipate extending the LWA Professional Services Agreement beyond December 31, 2019.

### Question 3

Will LWA be tasked with assisting the City in obtaining the NPDES permit for the proposed stormwater outfall?

### Answer 3

For efficiency and managing only a single consultant PSA for the *Storm Drain Zones 36 & 39 Engineering, Environmental and Permitting project*, the City of Manteca will be looking to the successful consultant to obtain the NPDES permit for the proposed stormwater outfall.

### Note:

To this point, Sandy Mathews with LWA has been instrumental in arranging pre-permitting meetings with, (1) the Regional Water Quality Control Board, (2) the California Department of Fish and Wildlife, (3) the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, and (4) the Central Valley Flood Protection Board. These pre-permitting meetings were arranged and scheduled based on Sandy's professional network of contacts. Additionally, Sandy prepares an agenda then follows up with minutes for each meeting. The minutes have been included with the materials as part of this RFP.

If deemed beneficial by responding consulting firms, I encourage you to reach out to LWA (Sandy Mathews) to aid with obtaining the NPDES permit for the proposed stormwater outfall.
